GENERAL INFORMATION

Tax

HST (Harmonized Sales Tax) is a single value-added tax of 15 per cent on the cost of goods and services in the Maritime region. Seven per cent of the tax is federal, and the remaining eight per cent goes to the province of New Brunswick. In other parts of Canada, you will see taxes broken down into GST (Goods and Services Tax) and PST (Provincial Sales Tax) on your receipts, except in Alberta where there is no PST. When goods and services are used in the province, the tax is non-refundable for international visitors, but if you take a package, (for example, accommodation and meals), you are entitled to a 50% rebate on the GST and a 100% rebate on any other separate purchases.
